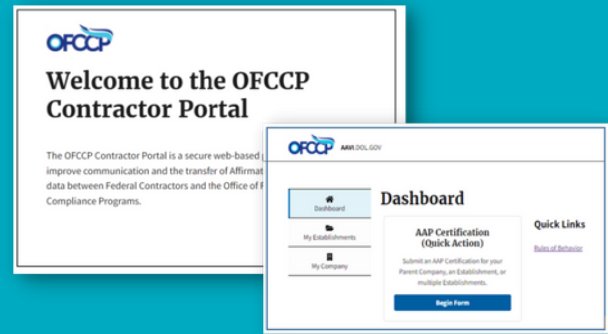

What is the OFCCP Contractor Portal

The OFCCP Portal is a secure web-based federal contractor portal created to improve communication and the transfer of Affirmative Action Program data, between Federal Contractors and the Office of Federal Contract Compliance Programs (OFCCP).

What is Required

Beginning February 1, 2022, supply and service contractors and subcontractors who meet certain jurisdiction thresholds are required to use the Contractor Portal to register and certify their AAP compliance. Specifically, contractors that hold a contract of \$50,000 or more and employ 50 or more employees must develop and maintain AAPs pursuant to Executive Order 11246 and Section 503 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973. If a contractor has at least 50 employees and a contract of \$150,000 or more, then it must also develop an AAP pursuant to the Vietnam Era Veterans' Readjustment Assistance Act of 1974.
